- 4) Tell us about the Teacher Performance Assessment (TPA) and your experience engaging with it as part of your preparation to teach.
- 5) Describe experiences working in Professional Learning Communities (PLCs) in your common content courses and the benefits of collaborating with colleagues in other content areas.
- 6) Provide a specific example of how you used technology in an interactive way.
- 7) Describe how you would make your content culturally relevant for your students.
- 8) What kind of student data do you use to inform your planning and instruction?
- 9) Discuss your experience or interest working with struggling learners.
- 10) List and describe three teaching strategies you feel most competent using.
